MAGICAL TOWNS: PALENQUE

 \mathbf{T} o really get to know get to know the famous ancient city of Palenque, visitors must immerse themselves deep into the history and mysticism of the Mayan Culture and its majestic ceremonial centers. To the north of the state of Chiapas lies both the ancient city of Palenque, built by the Mayans, and the modern town beneath it, which serve as a fantastic starting point to explore the natural wonders that surround them. A road interrupted by waterfalls leads south to the archaeological site of Tonina. If visitors head southeast, passing through the Lacandon Jungle, they will find the vestiges of two other great pre-Hispanic cities, Bonampak and Yaxchilán.

To come to this corner of the world is to touch the heart of the imposing Lacandon Jungle and let oneself be surprised by its sounds, beginning with the welcome given by the howler monkey and by the echoes of the legendary jaguar. Tourists are invited to bathe their senses among the turquoise crystal clear waterfalls and to enjoy the abundant nature surrounding them, which will fill their trip with life and color. The ancient city of Palenque, which lies deep inside the Mayan jungle, was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1987.

EIIS-OECD PACIFIC ALLIANCE SEMINAR IN STOCKHOLM

On December 5th, the seminar "The Pacific Alliance - An Emerging Region in a Global World: Towards Better Integration of Regional Policies and International Cooperation" was held in Stockholm with the participation of the Ambassadors of Colombia, Peru, Chile and Mexico as speakers, as well as the presence of Dr. Oscar Villarreal, Advisor to the OECD Sherpa Office before the G20. This seminar was organized by the European Institute of International Studies (EIIS) and the OECD, with the cooperation of the Swedish Ministry for Foreign Affairs, Business Sweden and the Embassies in Sweden of the four founding member countries of the Pacific Alliance.

In this forum, the dialogue and cooperation of the four members of the Pacific Alliance (PA) with observer or associate countries was promoted; 30 out of 52 observer or associate countries are members of the OECD. To this end, representatives from the Swedish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Business Sweden, the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg and the EIIS participated in the four panels held throughout the day. Ambassador Gasca Pliego participated in the panel "Gender Equality in the Pacific Alliance," in which he highlighted not only the work that the PA Working Group has carried out in this matter, but also "the contributions that the OECD could have on the subject given the research and analysis already carried out for the publication of the text: 'Gender Equality in the Pacific Alliance: Promoting the Economic Empowerment of Women."

The second installment of this panel is scheduled for February 2018.

The Chargée d'Affaires, a.i., Dr. Audrey Rivera Gómez of the Embassy of Mexico congratulated Beatrice Fihn, Executive Director of the International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons (ICAN), the organization which received the 2017 Nobel Peace Prize, for having obtained the highest award for her dedicated work against nuclear weapons. The ICAN brings together more than 500 NGOs in a hundred countries, and has been warning for years about the dangers posed by this type of weapon. Beatrice thanked the Chargée d'Affaires for her congratulations, mentioning that Mexico has great diplomats, and that she recognizes their position against nuclear weapons. The Chargée d'Affaires and the Executive Director of ICAN held their dialogue on Wednesday, December 13, in the framework of the acknowledgment that the Swedish Parliament made to ICAN.
