The Chargée d'Affaires, a.i., Audrey Rivera Gómez attended the invitation made by the Institute of Security and Development Policy of Sweden (ISDP) to participate in the Discussion Forum: "After the Trump-Kim Summit - Assessing the Deal," which took place at its headquarters on March 1, 2019.

Dr. Lars Vargö, Director of the Asia Program, welcomed attendees and highlighted the news of the second summit in Hanoi, Vietnam, between Presidents Trump and Kim Jong Un, on February 27 and 28, which "it is centered in the remarkable change of the US-North Korean relations; but while it was a historic opportunity for leaders of both countries to make significant progress in the peace and denuclearization process, they were more cautious in reaching concrete commitments." Dr. Vargö stressed that they addressed the long-term prospects of the peace process and denuclearization in North Korea without clear results. During his presentation, Dr. Sang Hyun Lee, from the Seoul Sejong Institute and a Visiting Fellow (Researcher) of the ISDP, explained how this historic point was reached, and he explained

for her recognition and nomination as Doctor Honoris Causa which will be awarded soon by the Karolinska Hospital. Dr. Ekman has contributed in fighting against diseases such as HIV, and she has been for 30 years director of the Karolinska School of Health Services in Solna. Dr. Ekman co-founded the Stiftelsen Läkare association in 1987 in the fight against HIV and raised funds in considerable sums for HIV research. She also spearheaded large-scale public health campaigns and improved school health services. Furthermore, she has worked on behalf of children, collaborated in the Just Say No anti-drug campaign and in the first global anti-smoking campaign. Dr. Ekman was also recognized for her contribution to the early detection of neuro-psychiatric diseases, learning disabilities and autism. Dr. Ekman invited Dr. Rivera Gómez to her formal ceremony that will take place on May 10 at Stockholm City Hall. This distinction has been awarded to Nelson Mandela and Bill Gates.

Therefore, during her speech she stressed that she has taken action to regulate Apple, Amazon, Facebook, Google, among others, since it is important that these companies establish clear data privacy rules with their users.

On March 19, 2019, the Chargée d'Affaires, a.i., Dr. Audrey Rivera Gómez held a courtesy call with Mr. Torbjörn von Schantz, Vice-Rector of Lund University. During the meeting, they dialogued, among other topics, about the relevance of increasing academic exchange in areas of technological innovation, mathematics, research and development, as well as humanities. The Vice-Chancellor von Schantz pointed out that there are 20 Mexican students enrolled in various disciplines, including environmental sciences, sociology and those related to technological innovation and computer science. He emphasized that there is an educational exchange agreement with the Monterrey Technological Institute of Higher Education (ITESEM) and he hopes to expand the educational exchanges with other Mexican institutions: "proposal that can be explore in the near future". Both highlighted the possibility of future meetings between Lund University and representatives of the Autonomous University of Mexico, National Polytechnic Institute, and Mexican Council on Science and Technology.
