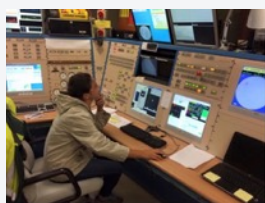


Five years ago, Mexico, Colombia, Chile, and Peru gave life to the Pacific Alliance, the most dynamic and promising regional integration scheme.
