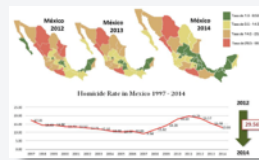

Mexicans joins mission to the moon

Mexico City.- The Mexican space agency, the AEM, will be sending a package of scientific instruments to the moon by 2018 to conduct experiments from there by remote control. Mexico will be the first Latin American country to do so.

The ministry of Communications and Transportation announced that the package will be sent to the moon by the Griffin lander of Astrobotic, an official associate company of NASA.

The contents of the package will be chosen by means of an open bidding process by the nation's scientific and technological community.



Tequila and mezcal star in Bordeaux



Bordeaux.- A dozen companies that produce mezcal and tequila will take part in the world's leading wine and spirits festival, Vinexpo in Bordeaux. The aim is to raise the international

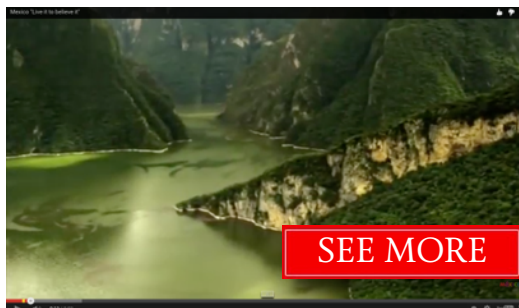
standing of what are Mexico's emblematic drinks.
